

MUNICIPALITY OF MCDOUGALL ELECTION 2010
Election Day is October 25, 2010

The Municipality of McDougall will be conducting the 2010 election through the vote by mail process. A copy of the authorizing by-law follows this page. As times and dates for ballot mailing become available, they will be posted on this site.

ARE YOU ENTITLED TO VOTE

A person is entitled to be a voter if on Voting Day (October 25, 2010) if he or she:

- a) is a Canadian citizen.
- b) is at least 18 years old.
- c) resides in the municipality or is the owner or tenant or the spouse (including same sex partner) of the owner or tenant of land in the municipality;

Persons Prohibited from Voting:

- a) a person serving a sentence in a penal or correctional institution (including a sentence served in the evenings or on weekends);
- b) a corporation;
- c) a person acting as executor or trustee or in any other representative capacity.;
- d) a person who has been convicted of corrupt practice described in s 90(3), if Voting Day in the current election is less than 5 years after Voting Day in the election in respect of which he or she was convicted.

ELIGIBLE COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

The place where a student's family resides is also their residence unless they have moved with the intention of changing their permanent lodging. A student may vote in the municipality where he or she is temporarily residing while attending school as well as at this or her permanent home in different municipality, provided that he or she has not abandoned the family home.

BY-LAW 2009 - 60

Being a By-law to Authorize Vote by Mail for the 2010
Municipal Election

WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, as amended, provides that a municipal council may at least sixty days prior to voting day, pass a by-law authorizing an alternative voting method;


AND WHEREAS Section 42, Subsection 5 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may use alternative voting in lieu of advance votes and voting proxies;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it appropriate and in the public interest to conduct the 2010 municipal election using a vote by mail system;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of McDougall enacts as a By-law of the Corporation as follows:

1. That the use of voting by mail, as an alternative voting method, is hereby authorized for the municipal election to be held in 2010.
2. That the provisions relating to proxy voting and advance voting will not apply in the 2010 municipal election.
3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon third and final reading.

READ a **FIRST** and **SECOND** time this 9 day of December 2009.




