

**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY
OF MCDOUGALL**

BY-LAW NO. 2003-06

Being a By-law to establish a Registry of Businesses in the
Municipality of McDougall

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 Section 157 authorizes the Council of a local municipality to pass a by-law establishing and maintaining a registry of businesses and require a business which is being carried on wholly or partly within the municipality, even if the business is being carried on from a location outside the municipality, to register and maintain its registration in the registry.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it advisable to establish a registry of businesses.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted as a By-law of the Corporation of the Municipality of McDougall as follows:

1. That businesses are:
 - (a) prohibited from the carrying on of or engaging in the business unless the business has registered in the registry;
 - (b) required on the Business Register Form , attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this by-law to provide the business name, ownership, contact information, including address, e-mail, website, telephone number, fax number and contact name and the type of business be provided;
 - (c) required to register, utilizing the aforementioned Business Registration Form, at least 14 days prior to engaging in business activity (initial registration) and thereafter register every year by January 30 of the current year;
 - (d) required, within 14 days, updated information for the registry to be provided if the information under clause (b) changes.
2. A registration shall be deemed refused if applicable Zoning or Official Plan requirements will be violated with the business being placed in the proposed location.
3. The Council shall have the right to revoke or suspend a registration if:
 - (a) the business is found to have supplied incorrect information relating to it's registration;
 - (b) upon the grounds that the conduct of any person, including the officers, directors, employees or agents of a corporation, affords reasonable cause to believe that the person will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity;

4. This by-law shall not apply to:
 - (a) a manufacturing or an industrial business, except to the extent that it sells its products or raw material by retail;
 - (b) the sale of goods by wholesale; or
 - (c) the generation, exploitation, extraction, harvesting, processing, renewal or transportation of natural resources.
5. By-law No. 97-02 being a by-law to regulate trades, occupations, business, hawkers and peddlers is hereby rescinded.
6. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof and shall expire on the 1st day of March 2008 or the day it is repealed, whichever comes first.
