
**WHEREAS** Section 210(1-13) of the Municipal Act, chapter M.45, R.S.O. 1990, as amended provides that the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws for the regulating and licencing of dogs;

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it expedient to regulate the number of dogs kept in a residence;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of McDougall enacts as follows;

- 1 (a) No owner or owners living at the same address shall keep more than three (3) dogs in any one household over the age of 3 months, located within any residential, ~~commercial, industrial~~ or water front zone in the Township of McDougall. *SR M SR M*
- (b) This section does not apply to:
  - i) the operation of a licenced kennel.
  - ii) an animal hospital owned and operated by a Veterinarian licenced by the Ontario Veterinarian Association.
  - iii) a pet store.
  - iv) a legally established pound or shelter.
2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.


