72 HOUR EMERGENCY SURVIVAL KIT

In the event of an emergency, everyone should be prepared to take care of themselves and their families for up to three days. Make sure that your emergency survival kit has:

- Flashlight and batteries
- Radio and batteries or crank radio
- Spare batteries
- First aid kit
- Candles and matches or lighter
- Extra vehicle keys and cash
- Important papers (ID)
- Food and bottled water
- Pet food and leash
- Clothing and footwear
- Blankets or sleeping bags
- Toilet paper and other personals
- Medication
- Whistle
- Playing cards or games
- Notify family of your evacuation plan
